



Celebrate Mother's Day with a fun and creative nature adventure! In this activity, children will make beautiful paper chrysanthemums as handcrafted gifts for their moms!

<u>Materials</u>

• Colorful Paper

• Glue

• Scissors

1. Cut out paper.

- a.1 (1x6 cm) to wrap around flower
- b.1 (4x6 cm) for small leaf
- c.1 (7x10 cm) for big leaf
- d.1 (10x30 cm) for flower
- e.1 (8.5 x11 in) for flower stem
- f.1 (8.5 x 5.5 in) for leaf stem
- 2. Tightly roll and glue closed the (8.5 x11 in) paper to act as your flower stem.
- 3. Tightly roll and glue closed the (8.5 x 5.5 in) paper to act as your leaf stem.
- 4. Fold the (10x30 cm) paper in half lengthwise and then half again widthwise.
- 5. Cut that paper into strips halfway through, leave the base untouched.
- 6. Ribbon curl the strips.
- 7. Apply glue to the base of the paper.
- 8. Wrap the base of the paper around the flower stem.
- 9. Fold the (4x6 cm) paper in half widthwise and then half again widthwise and cut it into leaf shapes.
- 10. Use the (1x6 cm) paper to wrap around the base of the flower to secure the small leaves in place and then glue closed.
- 11. Fold the (7x10cm) in half and cut a bigger leaf shape out.
- 12. Attach that big leaf to the leaf stem and attach the leaves to the flower.
- 13. You should now have a beautiful handmade chrysanthemum!
