SUMMER SUNCATORER



Capture the summer sunshine! In this fun and creative project, you'll create a beautiful suncatcher using flowers from your neighborhood while exploring the plants that grow in your city. Hang your suncatcher in a bright window and let the sunlight shine through, bringing a joyful burst of color into your home.

MATERIALS

Printed sun template – Flower petals – Yellow construction paper – Clear contact paper

STEPS:

- 1. Print out the sun template.
- 2. Cut out the template including the center circle.
- 3. Trace template onto material of choice. We used yellow construction paper.
- 4. Decorate the sun.
- 5. Cut out sun.
- 6. Cut out a circle of contact paper that fits around the sun's inner circle. Take your piece of contact paper and press it onto your sun and set aside.
- 7. Gather flowers.
- 8. Place flowers on sticky side of contact paper.
- 9. Hang in a sunny window and enjoy!
